

George Gipp

Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Excelled in baseball, football, basketball and hockey while attending CHS.

Starred on the CHS basketball team that won a UP championship in 1914.

Led Notre Dame in rushing during the 1918, 1919 and 1920 seasons.

Set Notre Dame career rushing records of 2,341 yards and 83 touchdowns.

He became Notre Dame's first All-American in 1920.

George Gipp Senior Athlete Award was established at CHS in 1934.

Gipp Memorial in Laurium was dedicated in his honor in 1935.

World War II liberty ship, SS George Gipp, named in his honor.

Selected as one of the top 25 college football players of all-time by ESPN.

Inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 1951.

Inducted into Michigan Sports Hall of Fame with Gordie Howe in 1957.

Inducted into the inaugural class of the UP Sports Hall of Fame in 1972.
