Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Multi-sport standout in an era prior to female inter-scholastic athletics.

Considered one of the finest women's softball pitchers in Michigan history.

In 1951, at the age of 14, she pitched her team to a UP Class A Championship.

Pitched her team to a Michigan Class D State Championship in 1972.

In 1994, the Holly Jean (Anderson) McCullah softball trophy was instituted in her name.

Was a dominant player in the Copper Country Women's Basketball League.

Bowled two 300 games and a local women's record 778 series.

In 2010, CHS named their outstanding senior female athlete award in her honor.

A consensus choice as one of the finest female athletes ever to attend CHS.

Inducted into the UP Sports Hall of Fame in 1973.
