Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Earned letters in football and track at CHS.

Was a standout in Hockey and Baseball while attending CHS.

Selected to the Copper Country All-Conference football team in 1967-68-69.

Elected to the 1969 Class A-B All-UP football team as a defensive back.

Set CHS track records in the 180 yard low hurdles, long jump and 880 yard relay.

Won the George Gipp Award in 1970 as the best senior athlete at CHS.

At age 17, he led the Northern Michigan-Wisconsin senior hockey league in scoring.

In baseball, he hit for high average with power in the local senior Twilight League.

Scored a WCHA record 28 goals as a freshman at Michigan Tech in 1970-71.

Was selected to receive the WCHA Outstanding Freshman Award in 1971.

In 109 games at MTU he scored 71 goals and 61 assists for 132 points.

Selected by the Los Angeles Kings in the 1972 NHL player draft.

Led the U.S. National Team to a gold medal at the 1974 World Hockey Championships.

Played professional hockey with the LA Kings organization for three years.

Inducted into the UP Sports Hall of Fame in 2001.

Inducted into the MTU Hall of Fame in 2008.
