Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Earned letters in football, basketball and track at CHS.

In 1935, started on the only undefeated and untied football team in CHS history.

Won the George Gipp Award in 1936 as the best senior athlete at CHS.

Competed in football and track at the University of Michigan from 1936-1939.

Served during WWII as a military police regimental government officer,
1st Lieutenant, U.S. Army, in the European Theater.

Coached track, football and basketball at CHS from 1950-1979.

His track teams won 17 consecutive Copper Country Invitational meets.

During his tenure as track coach, CHS won 21 conference and 9 regional titles.

In 1971 and 1975, his CHS team won the U.P. Class A-B State Championship.

Inducted into the UP Sports Hall of Fame in 1980.
