Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Lettered in both football and basketball at CHS.

Two-year starter as a forward on the CHS basketball team.

Was an outstanding two-way lineman for three years on the CHS football team.

Selected to the All-U.P. football team after the 1945 season.

Received the George Gipp Award as the outstanding senior athlete in the class of 1946.

Three-time letter winner in football as a lineman at the University of Michigan (1947-48-49).

Won the Big 10 Championship in 1947, 1948, and 1949.

Played on the undefeated 1947 and 1948 Michigan national championship teams.

Played in the 1948 Rose Bowl when the Wolverines beat the USC Trojans, 49-0.

Started as an offensive guard in 1948 and as a two-way lineman in 1949.

Inducted into the Upper Peninsula Sports Hall of Fame in 1980.
