

## **Jack Mugford**

### **Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame**

Lettered in basketball and track at CHS.

Captained both the basketball and track teams.

Helped lead the CHS basketball team to a regional championship over Ishpeming in 1936.

Set the school long jump record of 20' 6" which lasted for 33 years.

Excelled in baseball, fast pitch softball, intermediate hockey, independent basketball, golf and bowling.

Signed a professional baseball contract with the Philadelphia Phillies in 1940.

Played one year as a centerfielder with the Wausau Timberjacks in the Phillies minor league system.

Played many years with Liberty Loan which was one of the finest softball teams in the U.P.

Was a member of the Ahmeek intermediate hockey team and also played one year with the Portage Lake Pioneers.

Accomplished the rare feat of shooting a round of golf lower than his age with an 18 hole score of 69 when he was 70 years old.

Bowled a sanctioned 223 triplicate and had a career high three game series of 745.

Bowled a three game series against PBA Hall of Famer, Don Carter, at the Miller Lanes and only lost by one pin, 571-570.

Considered one of the finest all-around athletes in Copper Country sports history.

Inducted into the Upper Peninsula Sports Hall of Fame in 2012.
