Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Played and lettered in football as a lineman at CHS.

Earned four letters while playing football at Kalamazoo College (1917-1920).

Played against George Gipp and Notre Dame in 1919 and 1920.

Was voted Kalamazoo College's outstanding defensive player in 1920.

Was named to the MIAA All-Conference football team in both 1919 and 1920.

Selected to Kalamazoo College's all-time football team as a defensive lineman.

Coached football, hockey and track at CHS from 1926 to 1949.

Compiled a 58-46-7 record while coaching the CHS football team.

Continued coaching with the 7th & 8th grade football teams in Keweenaw during the 1950's.

Inducted into the Upper Peninsula Sports Hall of Fame in 1988.
