Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

Lettered in both football and basketball while attending Calumet High School (1935-1939).

Chosen to captain both the football and basketball teams during the course of his high school career.

Was a three-year starter in football as a running back, punter, and drop kicker (1936-1938).

Set school single game records by scoring 5 touchdowns and 33 points against Menominee (1938).

Named to the Copper Country All-Star Team as a running back for three consecutive years (1936-1938).

Selected twice as a 1st team All-U.P. running back (1937-1938).

Designated as the quarterback and captain of the All-U.P. Team (1938).

Honored by *The Detroit News* as their 1st team fullback on the 1938 All-State Team.

Was a starting forward on the CHS basketball team for three seasons (1936-1939).

Received the George Gipp Award as the outstanding senior athlete in the class of 1939.

Served in World War II with the 8th Army Air Force (1942-1945).

Graduated from Michigan Tech with a degree in metallurgical engineering (1949).

Had a distinguished 34 year career with the Michigan Department of Transportation (1951-1985).
