Calumet High School Athletic Hall of Fame

A native of Marquette who earned three basketball letters while playing for Bishop Baraga High School (1948-1951).

Served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War (1952-1955).

Joined the Michigan State Police as a trooper and retired as a detective after 27 years of service (1957-1984). Was transferred to Calumet in 1970 and remained there until the time of his passing in 2008.

Was the owner and president of Investigative Consultants from 1984-1999.

In Calumet, he became a tireless organizer, supporter, and worker for numerous organizations which raised funds for local charities and youth oriented programs.

During this time he also coached American Legion baseball (1971-1974) and teams in the CLK-TL Senior Little League (1976-80).

Became an avid supporter of Calumet High School and its athletic programs.

Was one of the key individuals in the establishment of the Calumet All Sports Booster Club in 1982 and was instrumental in its early success.

Continued to serve in positions of leadership in the booster club for over two decades.

To this day, the Calumet High School All Sports Booster Club plays a key role in providing financial support to the CHS athletic program.
